
**Enlargement and Increase in Admission Number at Eversley Primary School,
Chaseville Park Road, Winchmore Hill, N21 1PD**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that London Borough of Enfield intends to make a prescribed alteration to Eversley Community Primary School, Chaseville Park Road, Winchmore Hill, N21 1PD from 1st September 2009.

The prescribed alteration involves the enlargement of the premises to enable the School to increase its intake from 60 to 90 pupils a year.

The current capacity of the school is 420 and the proposed capacity will be 630. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 427. The current admission number for the school is 60 and the proposed admission number will be 90.
