

LONDON BOROUGH OF ENFIELD**INTRODUCTION OF THE ENFIELD EVENT DAY ZONE [ZONE SS], AND AMENDMENTS TO WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield (the Council) made on 11 February 2026 The Enfield (Event Day) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2026 and the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 270) Traffic Order 2026 under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

1. The general effect of the Orders which come into force on 01 April 2026 will be to:
 - (1) Introduce an event day zone (zone SS) with controls operating Noon to 9pm on event days in Leonard Road, Sunnyside Road East, Sunnyside Road North and Sunnyside Road South.
 - (2) Match day permits are currently free for residents with up to 3 permits allowed per household
 - (3) Double yellow line (no waiting at any time) restriction amendments in Leonard Road, Sunnyside Road East, Sunnyside Road North and Sunnyside Road South.
2. 3. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

The Enfield (Event Day) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2026

Made 11 February 2026

Coming into operation 01 April 2026

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) (as amended), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Enfield (Event Day) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2026 and shall come into operation on 01 April 2026.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order, “the Order of 2018” means the Enfield (Event Day) (Parking Places) Order 2018(b).
(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
(3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2018 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2018 shall have effect as though:

(a) 1984 c.27(b) L.B.E. 2018/46

- (1) there were added to Schedule 1 to that Order the items set out in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- (2) there were added to Schedule 3 to that Order the items set out Schedule 2 to this Order.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2018 thereto

4. (1) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and, bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 1.8 metres is designated as a parking place.

(2) The provisions of the Order of 2018 (other than Articles 3 and 5) shall apply to the areas designated as parking places by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order, as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2018 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

5. The Council shall:
- (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place designated by this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place designated by this Order traffic signs indicating that such parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 5 of the Order of 2018;
 - (c) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

1268	SUNNYSIDE ROAD NORTH (zone SS), the north side, (a) from a point 6.6 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Victoria Road south-eastward for a distance of 38.3 metres. (b) From a point 2.1 metres west of common boundary of Nos. 15 and 16 Sunnyside Road North westward for a distance of 37.1 metres.
1269	SUNNYSIDE ROAD NORTH (zone SS), the south side, (a) from a point 5.3 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Sunnyside Road East north-westward for 34 metres. (b) from a point 6.6 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Victoria Road south-eastward for a distance of 33.7 metres.

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on 01 April 2026 and may be cited as the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 270) Traffic Order 2026.
2. In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2012(b) shall have effect as though for the items numbered 1699, 1704, 1705, and 1706 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order.
