Re: Fireworks Display at Enfield Town Park on Saturday 8th November 2025

I would like to provide you with further information regarding the proposed Fireworks Display at Enfield Town Park on **Saturday 8th November 2025**.

We are working to deliver this exciting event and hope that this event brings the community together to enjoy the forthcoming display.

The event will take place **on Saturday 8th November 2025** between 4pm and 8pm. The display will be a fully choreographed firework extravaganza lasting approximately 15 minutes scheduled for around 6.30pm. The event will include lots of family activities including performances as well as catering outlets.

Tickets can be purchased in advance of the event online via [Enfield Town Park Fireworks | Dugdale Arts Centre](#) or at the box office at the Dugdale centre in Enfield Town.

Digital tickets are not available for this event. Tickets are now on sale for this event and can be collected once a purchase has been made by visiting DAC, 39 London Rd, London, Enfield EN2 6DS in person with your order number and ID by 5:00pm Friday 7 November 2025. We advise collecting before **Friday 7 November** to avoid any queues or delays. The event will have a capacity limit of 5,000 people and last entry is **6pm** at Enfield Town Park.

The construction and event schedules have been confirmed as follows:

During the event set up deliveries will predominantly use the Essex Road entrance into the Park. There will be security and traffic management in place at Essex road to minimise any issues during the set up and throughout the event and also in the park overnight to oversee safety of equipment on site. On the morning of Friday 7th November 2025 there will be large vehicles using Essex Road entrance, with most vendors arriving from 11am on Saturday 8th November 2025. The park will be closed to the public from 11am on Saturday 8th November 2025. Some larger vehicles will access the site from 7am on Monday 10th November 2025 to collect event infrastructure i.e. fencing etc

Attendees will be permitted to access the park at either the Cecil Road gate or the gate adjacent to Enfield Town Community Church, attendees will not be permitted access via Essex Road.

There will be no residential access on the intersection of the New River loop as shown within the photos below between 4pm to 8pm for public safety during the fireworks display. Notices will be suitably placed in advance of the event.



There will also be traffic management officers deployed in Raleigh Road, Sydney Road, Uvedale Road, Walsingham Road, Park Crescent and Essex Road restricting access to residents only between 15:00pm and 20:15pm.

If I want to attend how do I obtain tickets?

What travel information is provided to customers attending the event?

What roads will be affected and when?

Pre event:

No Waiting Cones will be deployed at the entrance to the Park via Essex Road during the set up and breakdown of the event.

During the event:

Resident Access only into the following Roads

Uvedale Road

Walsingham Road

Park Crescent

Rayleigh Road

Sydney Road

Essex Road

What measures are being taken to stop people parking in the residential areas surrounding the park?

A traffic management company has been engaged to manage traffic surrounding the park. They will be stationed in all of the roads mentioned above in order to ensure that access is restricted to residents only. They will be present between 15:00pm and 20:15pm on Saturday 8th November 2025. The Council's Parking Enforcement Team have been notified

of the event and will be present in the area.

Who do I contact if a vehicle is blocking my access to my home/business?

What if road closures affect access to my property?

Residents will still be permitted access into the side roads. Road marshals will ensure free access to residents and residents are recommended to carry a copy of this letter OR proof of address when entering your road by car.

Will the event affect public transport?

Although tube and bus services will be busier than usual, TfL envisions a normal service throughout the weekend.

Is there a cleansing operation in place for areas outside of the park?

There is a cleansing operation for areas both inside and outside of the park. Enfield Council's Staff will provide extra cleansing of the surrounding areas during and immediately after the event.

Who should I contact if I want to report issues to do with litter or street cleansing as a result of the event?

Will I be able to use the rest of the park and if so, will it be safe?

The Park will be closed from 11:00am on Saturday 8th November 2025 and will reopen as per normal park opening times on Sunday 9th November 2025. There will still be some of the event infrastructure leaving the site on Monday 10th November 2025 and recommend members of public to be cautious of any moving vehicles.

What is being done to address anti-social behaviour?

Entry and exit from the event will be tightly controlled by an independent security company. Access to the event is via Cecil Road entrance and the gate beside Enfield Community Church and way finders will redirect people to use the correct entrance.

The event will **not** include the sale of alcohol and attendees are not allowed to bring any liquids into the event.

All security staff are SIA-accredited (the industry standard) and well-trained in dealing with crime and disorder issues. Any member of the public causing a nuisance will be required to leave the site and a note of this made in our records.

In addition, the Police are aware of this event and will intermittently be in attendance.

Who should I contact if I want to complain about noise from the event?
