ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

The Enfield (Conduit Lane N18)
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2019

Made - 13 November 2019

Coming into operation - 16 November 2019

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, being the traffic authority for Conduit Lane N18, in the London Borough of Enfield, and being satisfied that traffic should be regulated on that road in connection with essential utility works on Meridian Way N9 and N18, and in so far as Conduit Lane is an alternative route, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) and (5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on 16 November 2019 and may be cited as the Enfield (Conduit Lane N18) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2019.

2. Until the said works have been completed, and subject to Article 3 of this Order, every person causing any vehicle to proceed in a westerly direction in Conduit Lane N18 in the London Borough of Enfield shall cause that vehicle, on reaching the junction with Montagu Road and Kenninghall Road, to proceed ahead into that length of Conduit Lane N18 which lies west of that junction:

Provided that nothing in this Article shall apply in relation to a vehicle turning left into Kenninghall Road N18 from the carriageway that lies on the south-east side of the triangular traffic island situated at the junction of Conduit Lane with Kenninghall Road.

3. The provisions of Article 2 of this Order shall apply only at such times as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(a).

4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle that is engaged on the said works, or to a bus (as defined in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016) or to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
