FLU VACCINE

- Given from Reception class to Year 11
- Flu is unpleasant and can be very serious, causing pneumonia, bronchitis, or making long-term conditions worse (like asthma).

HPV VACCINE

- Offered in Year 8 (ages 12 and above)
- Protects against cancers caused by HPV (such as cervical cancer) and genital warts

3 IN 1 TEENAGER BOOSTER

- Given in Year 9 (ages 13 and above)
- Protects against Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio, which can cause serious and potentially life-threatening effects such as paralysis from polio and severe muscle spasms from tetanus.

MenACWY vaccine

- Given in Year 9 (ages 13 and above)
- Protects against meningitis and blood poisoning (septicaemia)

MMR VACCINE

- Protects against measles, mumps and rubella, which are highly contagious viral diseases that can cause serious complications such as pneumonia, meningitis, infertility and even death
