

Child Q Task & Finish Group

Terms of Reference

1) Purpose of Task & Finish Group

- To explore the learning from the Child Q CSPR against local practice and complete multiagency bench marking to highlight where practice needs to change in line with the recommendations.
- To review the recommendations and implement the learning from Child Q CSPR.
- All agencies to review their **own** practice against the recommendations from the Child Q CSPR.
- To enable a collaborative multi-agency response from Enfield Safeguarding Children Partnership.
- To formulate an action plan to address any areas of improvement required.

2) Group Responsibilities

- Each agency representative is responsible for the development of their own agencies action plan benchmarking and assessment.
- The group will provide constructive challenge to agencies, as part of the bench marking process.
- A report of the work undertaken to be shared with the Executive Board following the completion of work.
- To group will consider any further work or ongoing themes that may require the extension of the Task and Finish Group or implementation group.

3) Governance

- The Task and Finish Group will report into the Practice Improvement Group to share progression on any areas of development identified.
- The group is accountable to the Executive Board

4) Membership (Agencies)

- Children's Services
- Education
- Health Acute, Community and Mental Health
- Police

5) Arrangements for Meetings

- The Task and Finish Group will meet six weekly for six months and be chaired by Designated Nurse for Safeguarding Children, or the Children Business Manager.
- Agendas and papers will be despatched 5 days prior to the meeting in order to provide time for members to read them and identify actions for their own organisations.
