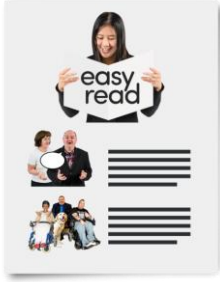


Top Tips on Independent Travel

Our Community Safety book has top tips on being safe when you are out and about.



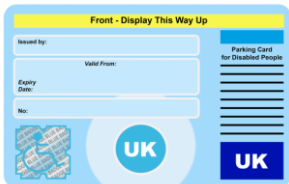

Dial-a-ride is a free door to door transport service for disabled people who cannot use mainstream public transport.

If you're disabled, you can apply for a **Blue Badge** (not Easy Read) which allows you to park closer to your destination without purchasing a ticket.



A **Freedom Pass** (not Easy Read) allows eligible people to use public transport for free.



The London Taxicard Scheme uses black cabs and minicabs at a reduced rate for people with disabilities who find public transport difficult or impossible.
