

CHURCH STREET, AINSLEY CLOSE N9 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential utility works on the roads detailed in the heading to this notice, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield have made the Enfield (Church Street, Ainsley Close N9) (No.1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2026, under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the Order will be to temporarily restrict traffic, as and when directed by traffic signs, and as detailed in the streets specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services' vehicles.

4. The prohibitions will operate during the times and on the dates specified in column 2 of the Schedule in each case and will continue until the works are completed. Access will be maintained for residents of Ainsley Close.

SCHEDULE

Part of Street to be Restricted 1	Coming into operation 2
Church Street N Waiting and Loading Restrictions - between its junction with Little Bury Street N9 and Firs Park Avenue N21, on both sides of the road; and Church Street Banned Movement – no right turn into Ainsley Close from Church Street into Ainsley Close and no left turn from Church Street into Ainsley Close.	2 September 2026 at any time for 15 weeks or until works are completed.
Ainsley Close N9 Banned Movement – no right turn from Ainsley Close into Church Street and no left turn from Ainsley Close into Church Street.
