

## FIRS LANE, N21 – INTRODUCTION OF DISABLED PARKING PLACES

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield (the Council) have made The Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 7) Traffic Order 2025, under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect of the Order which will come into operation on 12 January 2026 be to:
  - introduce two disabled persons parking places to operate 'At any time' with a maximum stay of 2 hours and no return in 1 hour, adjacent to the Firs Lane wetlands visitor entrance on the eastern kerbline of Firs Lane from a point 5m north of the common boundary of homes 249 and 251 Firs Lane to a point 14m south of that point.
3. Copies of the Order, Notice, Plans and of the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected at the Town Library, 66 Church Street, Enfield EN2 6AX, Monday to Fridays 9am – 5pm inclusive. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

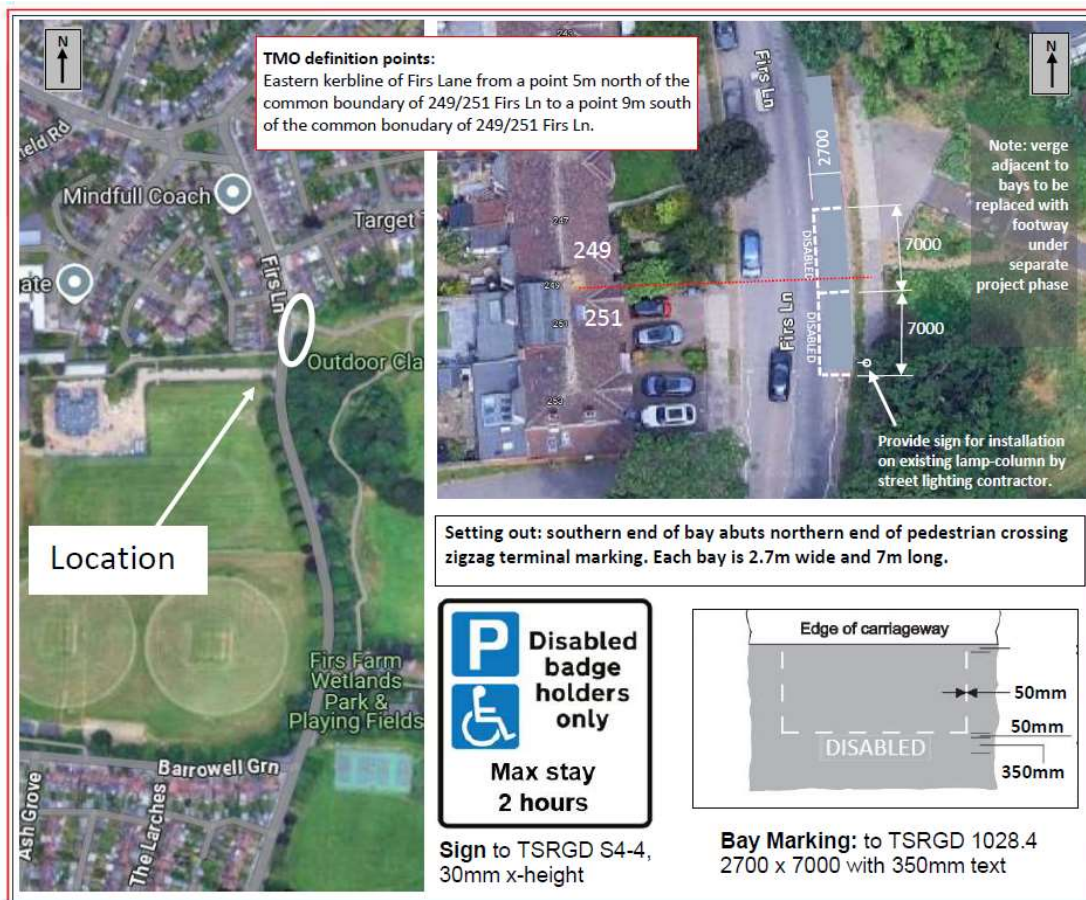

# Statement of Reasons

## Proposed Disabled Bays at Entrance to Firs Lane Wetlands

Enfield Council has identified the need for additional parking facilities for blue badge holders visiting the Firs Lane Wetlands.

The two disabled bays are proposed to operate at any time. A 2-hour time limit is proposed to deter long-stay domestic usage by blue badge holders living nearby, maximising the chance of blue badge holding patients finding the space vacant when making visits.

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Enfield (Free Parking Place) (Disabled Persons) (No.7) Traffic Order 2025 and shall come into operation on 12 January 2026.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order “the Order of 2017” means the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 7) Order 2017(b).
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2017 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

3. (1) The area on a street comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 2.7 metres, is designated as a parking place.

(2) The provisions of the Order of 2017 (other than Articles 3, 12 and 13) shall apply to the area designated as a parking place by this Order, as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to the area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2017 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Period for which a vehicle may be left in a parking place

4. During the permitted hours, no person shall cause any vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge to be left for a continuous period of more than two hours in the parking place designated by this Order and once so left after that period of two hours, shall not return to the said parking place within one hour.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

5. The Council shall place and maintain traffic signs, where necessary, indicating the limits of the parking place designated by this Order and that such parking place may only be used by vehicles specified in Article 4 of the Order of 2017.
