- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate footway works on Queen Elizabeth's Drive N14 Halstead Road N21 and Ridge Road N21, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield propose to make the Enfield (Queen Elizabeth's Drive N14, Halstead Road N21 and Ridge Road N21) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2019 under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- The effect of the Order would be to temporarily prohibit vehicles, as and when directed by traffic signs, to enter or proceed and from waiting and loading, in the street specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice.
- The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 would not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services' vehicles.
- The prohibitions would operate during the times and on the dates specified in column 2 of the Schedule in each case and would continue until the works are completed.
