Proposed 3G Football Pitch FAQ'S

1. Will there be any light and noise mitigation for neighbouring properties?

Yes. A 3m-high acoustic barrier will be installed to the east of the pitch to help protect nearby residential properties from noise. The floodlighting will also be designed to minimise impacts on neighbouring homes and will meet relevant lighting standards.

2. Will the 3G football pitch be secured?

Yes. The pitch will be enclosed by 4.5m-high perimeter fencing to provide security and help minimise vandalism, trespassing, and anti-social behaviour.

3. Where will football players park?

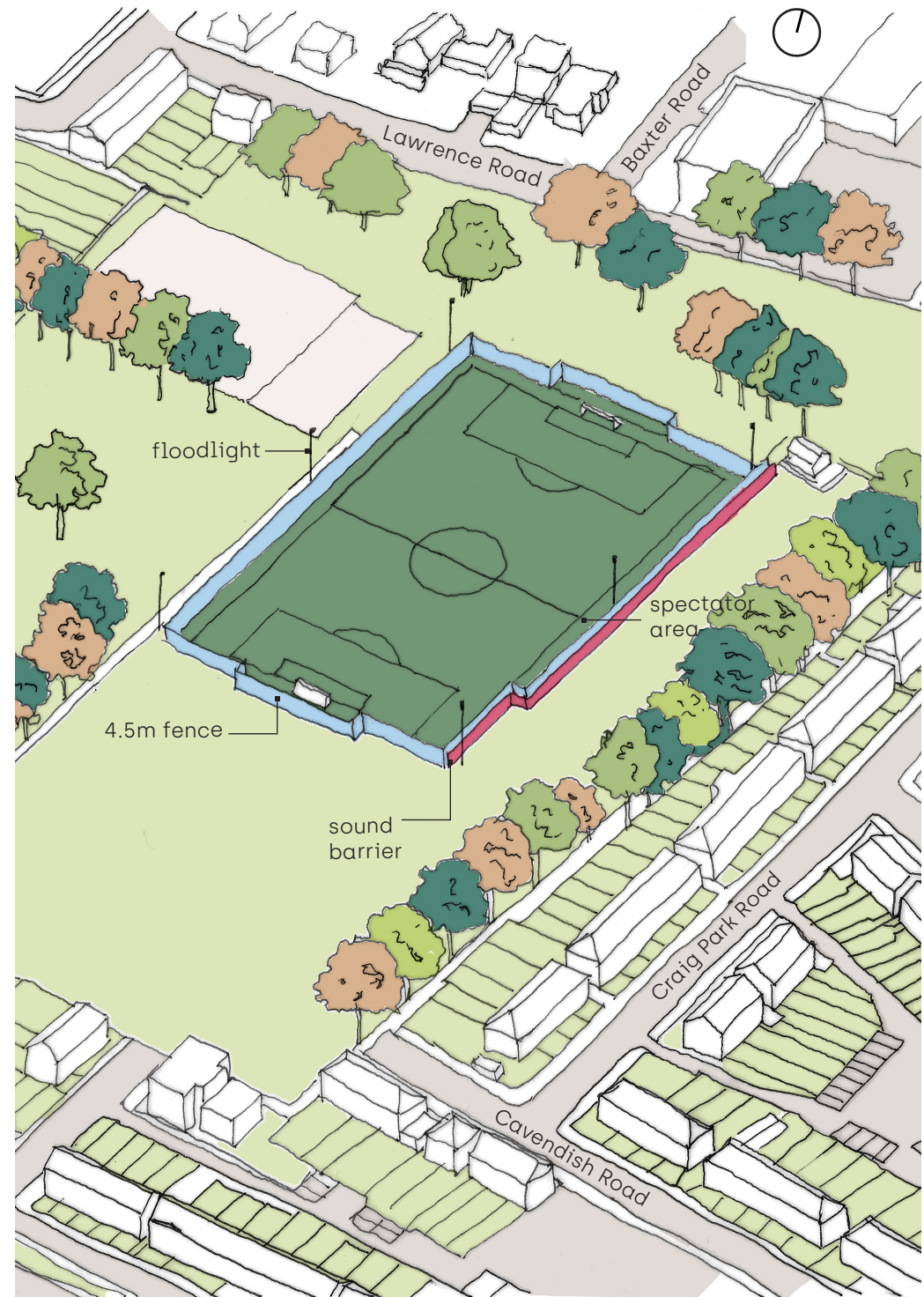
Walking, cycling and public transport use will be actively encouraged. Craig Park is well served by public transport and the pitch will be primarily used for youth football. A managed booking system will help minimise parking impacts on surrounding streets.

4. What are the proposed hours of use?

- Monday to Friday: 8:00am to 10:00pm
- Saturday and Sunday: 8:30am to 6:00pm

5. How will the community benefit?

The full-size 3G football pitch at Craig Park will improve community access to quality football facilities, provide more opportunities for children and young people to take part in sport, and support local teams.
