Homes for Ukraine – our role in supporting you

- Property inspections
- Home Office liaison
- DBS checks – criminal record checks
- Administer payments
- Named caseworker
- Welfare checks and reviews

Ukrainian Evacuees in Enfield

- 181 matched households
- Accommodation through the Homes for Ukraine scheme
- 132 Ukrainians in the scheme, including 25 children
- Support with:
 - Welfare
 - Accessing benefits, schools, GPs and ESOL classes
 - Referrals to wider community groups

Next steps

- Mutual support network
- Building resilience
- Mediation service
- Respite accommodation
- Assistance in gaining employment and/or training
- Assistance with securing settled accommodation (placements are for six months)

What happens after six months:

- Extend the current arrangements
- Rematch with another host
- Secure own accommodation
- Find your Own Home Scheme
 - Help with deposit and rent in advance
 - Negotiating with landlord
 - Support with furnishings etc

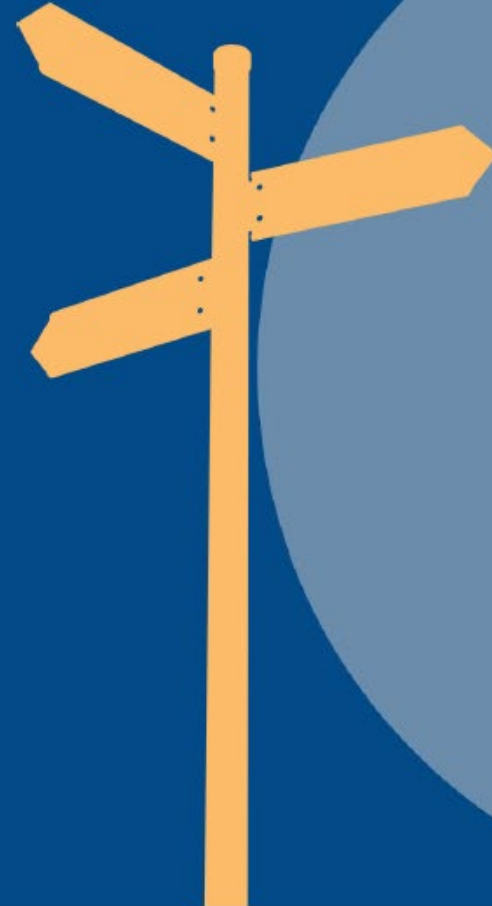

- immigration

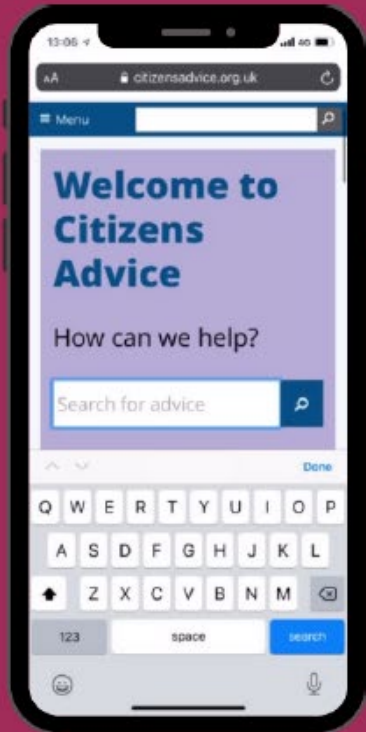


You won't always need to give us a call - our national website has lots of useful information and resources.

The NHS Started Providing Care In 1948

- At that time the UK had very high rates of infectious disease.
- These included Tuberculosis, Poliomyelitis, Measles and Diphtheria.
- Some of these were treatable some were not and had to be prevented.
- Improved living and housing standards, health education, screening and vaccinations all helped to control these problems.

Successful Vaccination Programmes

- Polio
- Measles
- Tuberculosis
- Rubella
- Meningitis
- Vaccinations are offered free during childhood and for at-risk adults.
- The only mandatory vaccinations are for some medical and social care staff.

Vaccinations Now

- Routine vaccinations remain very important.
- Infectious diseases are controlled, not conquered.
- This includes Coronavirus – vaccinations remain crucial in this area.
- We may be starting to see the return of some infectious diseases, in part because some people are not taking offered vaccines.
- Vaccines are a safe, effective and simple way of keeping us and those around us healthy.
- If you have concerns or queries around this – just ask us – it's what we are here for.

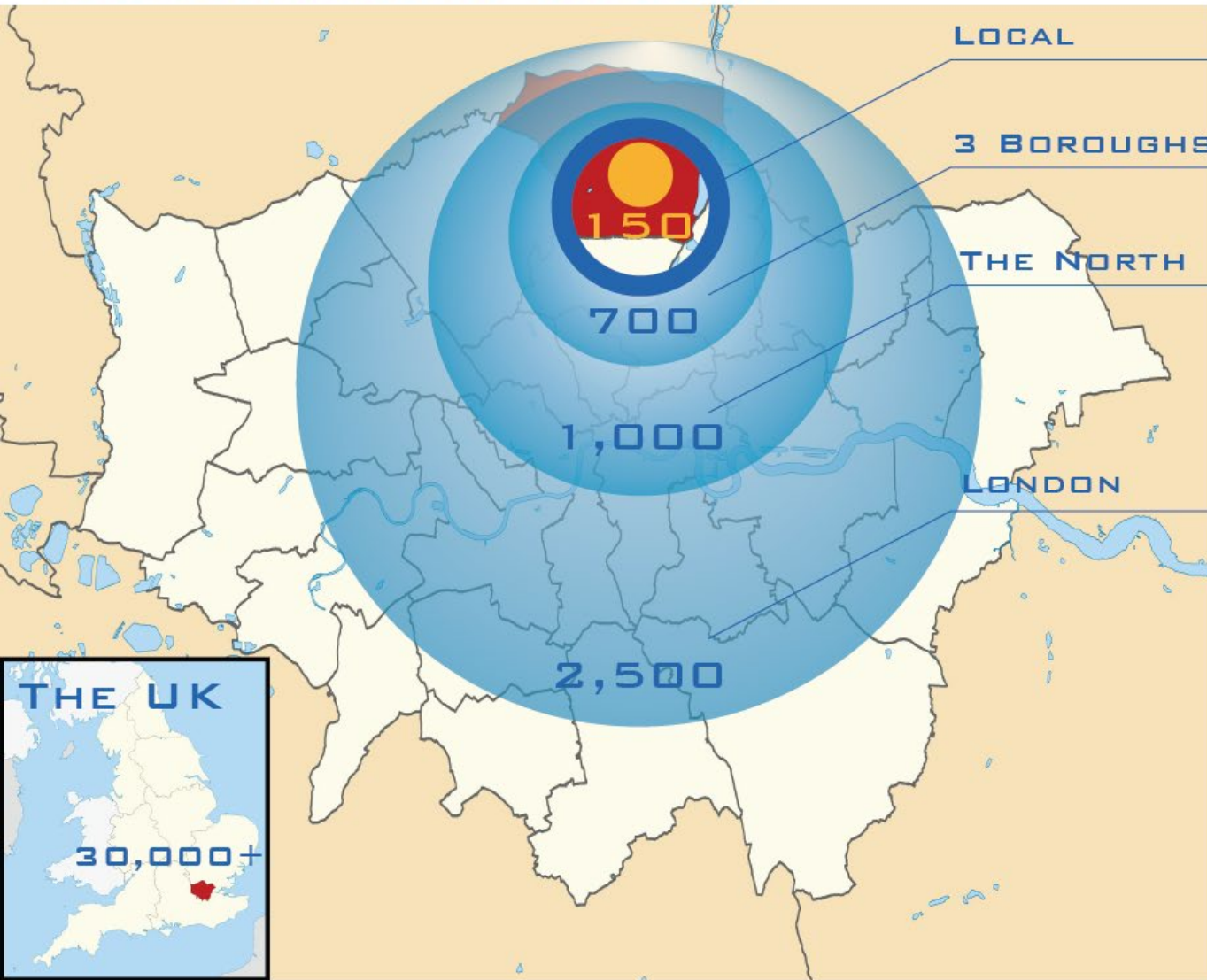

OUR PROJECTS: ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES FOR ADULTS

Problem: THE MAJORITY OF NEWLY ARRIVED PEOPLE FROM UKRAINE FEEL SHORTAGE OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE SKILLS WHICH MAKES IT DIFFICULT FOR THEM TO FIND A JOB.

Solution: WE LAUNCHED REGULAR OFFLINE ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES WITH A PROFESSIONAL TUTOR (WHO IS ALSO A UKRAINIAN REFUGEE).



Budget: THIS PROJECTS REQUIRES CONSTANT FUNDING AS WE PAY FOR THE TUTOR'S WORK.

THE MONTHLY COST OF LESSONS FOR A GROUP OF 6-7 PEOPLE (TWO LESSONS PER WEEK) IS **£180.**

THERE ARE TWO GROUPS OF STUDENTS AT THE MOMENT (14 PEOPLE), BUT THE AMOUNT OF APPLICATIONS IS INCREASING.

OUR AIM IS TO OPEN ADDITIONAL GROUPS OF VARIOUS LEVEL OF LANGUAGE SKILLS

OUR PROJECTS: SUMMER ACTIVITIES FOR CHILDREN

Problem: THE MAJORITY OF NEWLY ARRIVED FAMILIES CONSIST OF WOMEN WITH THEIR CHILDREN. WHILE MOST OF THEM WOULD SPEND SUMMER HOLIDAYS AT THEIR GRANDPARENTS' OR IN SUMMER CAMPS IN PEACEFUL TIMES, THEY ARE OBVIOUSLY DEPRIVED OF SUCH AN OPPORTUNITY NOWADAYS.

Solution: OUR IDEA IS TO HELP UKRAINIAN KIDS TO JOIN SUMMER ACTIVITIES WHICH WILL BRING SOME SENSE OF NORMALITY TO THEIR LIVES.



WE CONSIDER LAUNCHING SUCH ACTIVITIES OR FIND A WAY FOR OUR CHILDREN TO JOIN THE EXISTING SUMMER CAMPS AROUND ENFIELD

OUR PROJECTS: FREE SHOP FOR UKRAINIAN REFUGEES

Problem: FLEEING HOME WITH A SMALL EMERGENCY BAG MEANS THAT PEOPLE FACE A NEED OF CLOTHES, FOOTWEAR AND OTHER NECESSITIES WHEN THEY COME TO A NEW PLACE.

Solution: THANKS TO MANY KIND PEOPLE, WE'VE ALREADY COLLECTED A BUNCH OF ESSENTIAL ITEMS FOR PEOPLE IN NEED AND THEIR AMOUNT IS CONSTANTLY INCREASING. WHILE DOZENS OF PEOPLE HAVE ALREADY RECEIVED MATERIAL HELP, WE START RUNNING OUT OF SPACE TO STORE STUFF.



ONE OF OUR BIGGEST NEEDS AT THE MOMENT IS FINDING A PLACE WHERE WE COULD STORE ALL THE COLLECTED ITEMS AND WHERE PEOPLE COULD COME AND CHOOSE WHATEVER THEY NEED.
