(Personalised Disabled Persons) (No.1) Order 2026

Made: 15th June 2026

Coming into Operation: 29th June 2026

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Personalised Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2026 and shall come into operation on 29th June 2026

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order “the Order of 2017” means the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Personalised Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2017(b).

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

(3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2017 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Amendment

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability occurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2017 shall have effect as though for the:-

- (a) items in the Schedule to that Order numbered 487, 808 and 817 and there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in Schedule 1 to this Order;
- (b) items numbered 27, 229, 259, 273, 370, 473, 474, 492, 511, 538, 544, 545, 550, 598, 616, 665, 669, 727, 738, 754, 755, 764, 782 and 789 in Schedule 2 to that Order are hereby revoked.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2017 thereto

4. (1) Each area on a street comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 2.70 metres, is designated as a parking place.

(2) The provisions of the Order of 2017 (other than Articles 3, 12 and 13) shall apply to the areas designated as a parking place by this Order, as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to the Schedule to the Order of 2017 included a reference to Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

5. The Council shall place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place designated by this Order and that such parking place may only be used by vehicles specified in Article 4 of the Order of 2017.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order revokes and designates new personalised disabled permit parking places, in the London Borough of Enfield.
