

THE GREEN N9 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential utility works on the roads detailed in the heading to this notice, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield have made the Enfield (The Green N9) (No.1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2026, under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the Order will be to temporarily restrict traffic on a phased basis, as and when directed by traffic signs, and as detailed in the streets specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services' vehicles.

4. The prohibitions will operate during the times and on the dates specified in column 2 of the Schedule in each case and will continue until the works are completed.

5. Whilst the prohibitions are in force, the alternative routes for diverted vehicles will be as stated in column 3 in each case. Access will be maintained for residents only as far as the works allow.

SCHEDULE

Part of Street to be Restricted 1	Coming into operation 2
The Green N9 Waiting and Loading Restrictions – for approximately 150m between Balham Road and Hertford Road N9, on the northeast side of the carriageway. Cycle Lane Closure - from Balham Road N9 on the northeast side for approximately 110m to Church Street N9.	21 July 2026 at any time, for 16 weeks or until works are completed
