NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 123(2A) of the Local Government Act 1972 that the Mayor and Burgesses of the London Borough of Enfield (the Council) intend to grant a lease of the Property (a disposal), which is part of open space, for a term of up to 15 years.

By virtue of Section 123 (2A) of the Local Government Act 1972 the Council is required to give formal notice of its intention to dispose of open space and consider any objections to the proposed disposal. Any person who objects to the proposed disposal must lodge his or her objection in writing by email clearly stating the reasons for the objections to Property matters@enfield.gov.uk, or by writing to Property Services, London Borough of Enfield, Civic Centre, Silver Street, Enfield, London EN1 3XA by no later than midnight on 24th June 2026. Any objections received will be considered by the Council.
