This information is designed to provide parents/carers with information about play and leisure activities that are available during the school holidays for children and young people with SEND.

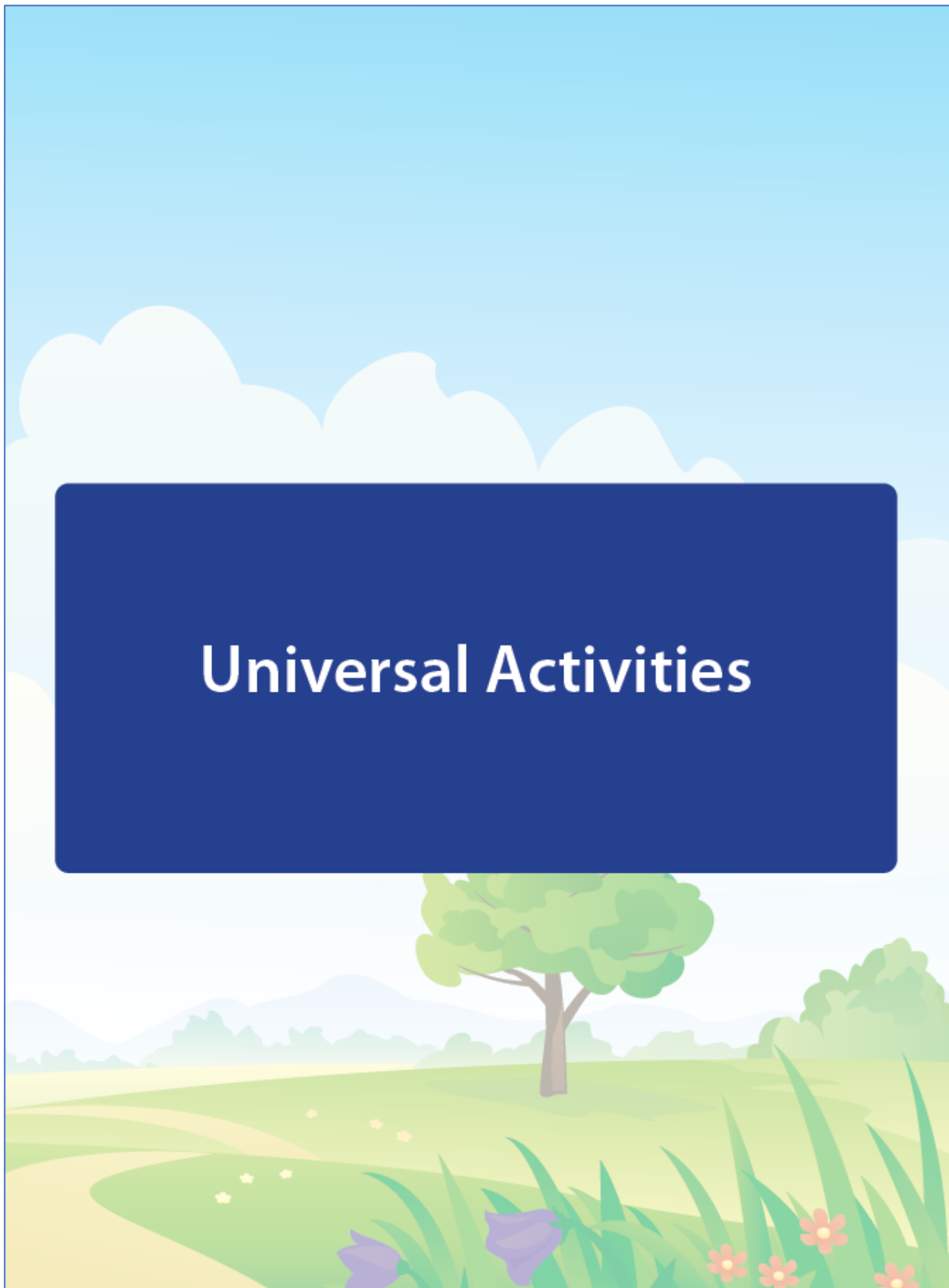
The information in this booklet is not exhaustive, and inclusion in this booklet does not mean that the Joint Service for Disabled Children endorses the activities. It is split into three sections:

1.	Universal Activities	These are inclusive activities that are accessible to all children and young people. You should talk directly with the provider to find out whether they can meet the needs of your child. You need to book and pay for these yourself. If you are in receipt of a Short Breaks Grant you can use this funding to pay for the activities.
2.	Universal Plus Activities	These are activities for children and young people with SEND who need some additional support. You need to book and pay for these activities yourself. If you are in receipt of a Short Breaks Grant you can use this funding to pay for the activities.
3.	Specialist Activities	These activities are for children and young people with SEND, who have complex needs. You may be referred to the activity and it will form part of your package of care. You can buy additional days directly from the provider, as can parents/carers who do not receive a care package.

SUMMER UNI UNIVERSAL PLUS

Whilst many young people with SEND successfully participate in mainstream Summer Uni activities, some young people may benefit from additional support, smaller group sizes, and a more tailored environment.

Our Universal Plus provision at Bell Lane Youth Centre has been specifically designed to support young people aged 11–19 (up to 25 with SEND) to participate in enjoyable activities, develop confidence, make friends, and learn new skills in a safe and supportive setting. The programme operates with a ratio of 1 staff member to every 5 young people, with 20 places available. Activities include:

And much more throughout the summer holidays.

Holiday activities and food programme (HAF)

Enfield's holiday activities and food programme (HAF) is fully funded by the Department for Education (DfE). It offers lots of fun ideas for keeping active, being creative and trying something new over the Easter, summer and winter school holidays.

Children and young people who get benefit-related free school meals, can get up to 4 days of free fun and nutritious food during the Easter and winter holidays, and up to 16 days during the summer holidays.

Each day will include a healthy meal, snacks and a selection of activities, ranging from sports and physical activities, food workshops and much more.

The programme covers a minimum of 1 week in the Easter holidays, 1 week in the winter holidays, and 4 weeks in the summer holidays, for a minimum of 4 hours per day, 4 days per week.

If your child requires additional support, share as much detail as possible on your booking to ensure the provider is fully equipped to support your child. You can also contact your HAF provider to discuss in further detail.

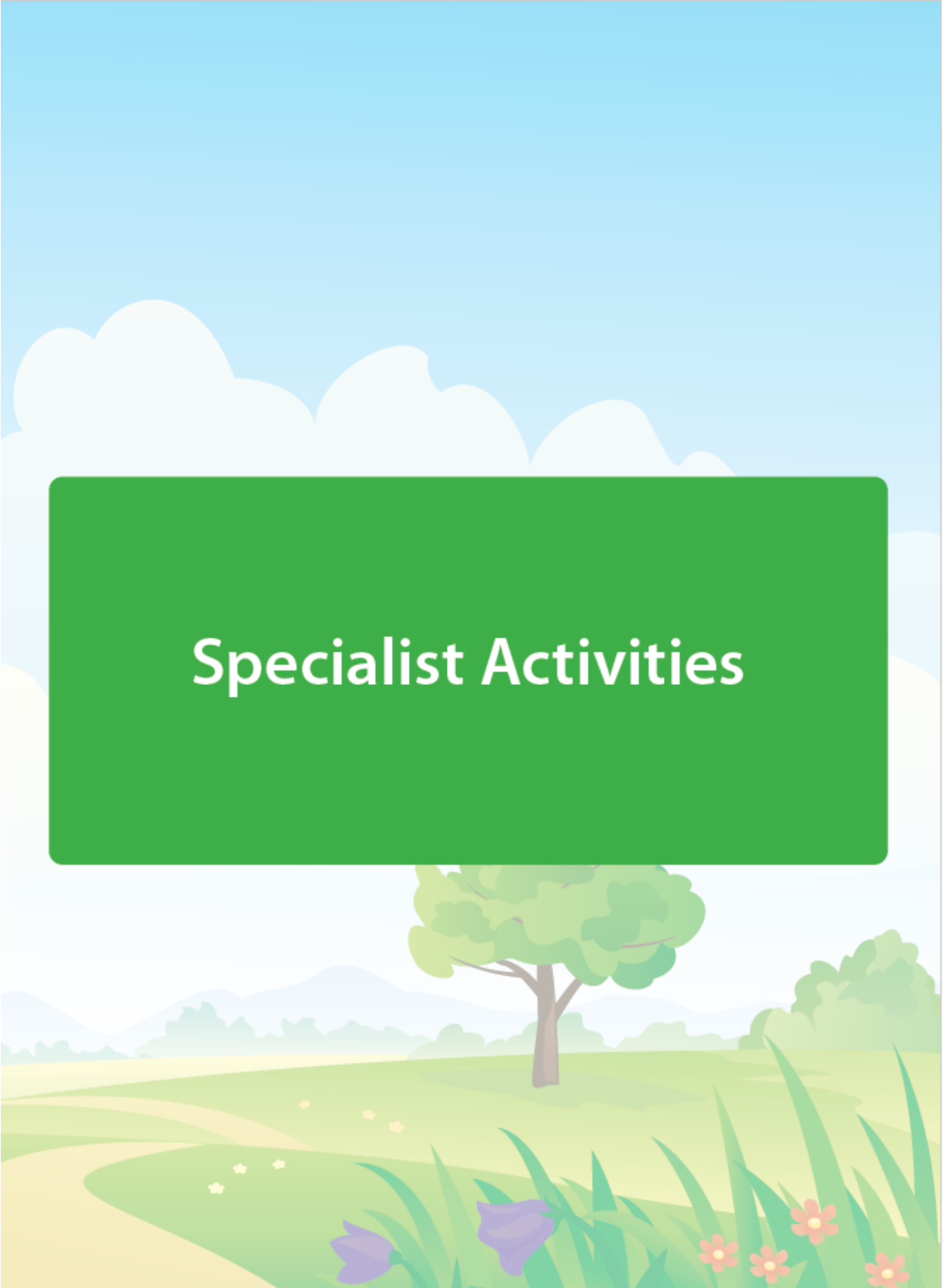
