**MASONS ROAD EN1 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC**

Further information may be obtained by telephoning Highway Services on 020 8379 2039.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential utility works on Masons Road EN1, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield have made the Enfield (Masons Road EN1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2019 under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit traffic from entering or proceeding on Masons Road between its junctions with Kempe Road and Elsinge Road, as and when directed by signage.
3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to works persons or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services personnel.
4. The prohibitions will come into operation on 20 November 2019 and will continue in force for 6 weeks or until works are completed.
5. Whilst the prohibitions remain in force, the diversion route will be via Kempe Road, Carpenters Road, Elsinge Road. Access will be maintained for residents as far as the works allow.

**WINDSOR ROAD N13 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential utility works on Windsor Road N13, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield propose to make the Enfield (Windsor Road N13) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2019 under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Order would be to prohibit traffic from waiting and loading on Windsor Road at any time, between the common boundaries between Nos. 16/18 and 34/36 for approximately 25 metres northbound, as and when directed by signage.
3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above would not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services vehicles.
4. The prohibitions would come into operation on 25 November 2019 and would continue in force 3 days or until works are completed.

**RAVENS CLOSE EN1 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential utility works on Ravens Close EN1, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield propose to make the Enfield (Ravens Close EN1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2019 under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Order would be to prohibit traffic from entering or proceeding on Ravens Close between the common boundaries of Nos. 13/15 and 15/17, as and when directed by signage.
3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above would not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services vehicles.
4. The prohibitions would come into operation on 27 November 2019 and would continue in force 3 days or until works are completed.
5. Access for residents would be maintained as far as the works allow.

**LAVENDER HILL EN2 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential highway works on Lavender Hill EN2, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield have made the Enfield (Lavender Hill EN2) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2019 under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit traffic from waiting and loading on Lavender Hill EN2 from the common boundaries of Nos. 18/20 to 58/60 on both the northern and southern sides, as and when directed by signage.
3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services vehicles.
4. The prohibitions will come into operation on 18 November 2019 and will continue in force for 5 days or until works are completed.

**CONDUIT LANE N18 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC**

Further information may be obtained by telephoning Highway Services on 020 8379 2039.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in connection with essential highway works on Meridian Way N18, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield have made the Enfield (Conduit Lane N18) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2019 under section 14(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. [Note: this Order continues the effect of a Notice dated 11th November 2019 given under section 14(2) of the said Act].
2. The effect of the Order will be to compel vehicles travelling in a westerly direction in Conduit Lane, at its junction with Montagu Road and Kenninghall Road, to continue ahead into Montagu Road in a westbound direction, as and when directed by traffic signs, unless they are turning left into Kenninghall Road.

N.B. This Order adds further temporary restrictions on traffic in Conduit Lane N18 to enable the introduction of additional signing to inform motorists of the restrictions at the Conduit Lane/Montagu Road junction.

3. The compulsory movement referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to works vehicles, buses, or to police or emergency services vehicles.
4. The compulsory movement will continue by way of the Order from 16th November 2019 until such time as the works have been completed.
5. Whilst the Order remains in force, the diversion route for vehicular traffic will be ahead into Montagu Road in a westbound direction, then via Angel Road N18, A406 Sterling Way N18, A10 Great Cambridge Road, A110 Southbury Road EN3 Hertford Road, Nightingale Road and Montagu Road.

**HARINGEY COUNCIL - PUBLIC NOTICE MOUNT PLEASANT ROAD, N17 - PROPOSED PLAY STREET THE HARINGEY (PLAY STREETS) (NO. 3) ORDER 2019 PS04**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey on 12th November 2019 made the above-mentioned Order under Section 29 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order is to introduce a play street for the purpose of enabling the road to be used as a playground for children and to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding in Mount Pleasant Road, N17 between its junctions with The Avenue and Chester Road, operating between the hours of 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. on the last Sunday in every month, throughout the year.
3. The Order will not apply to any vehicle requiring access to a property within the closed section of road providing that vehicle is travelling at a speed of no more than 5 m.p.h. and is supervised by an adult in high visibility clothing.
4. Copies of the Order referred to above, which will come into force on 14th November 2019, and of a Statement of Reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the reception desk, Alexandra House, 10 Station Road, Wood Green, N22 7TR or can be viewed online, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, at www.haringey.gov.uk/traffic\_orders.
5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it does not comply with the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
