This is extra money to help pay rent and housing costs.



From 1 April 2026 it replaces Discretionary Housing Payments (DHP)



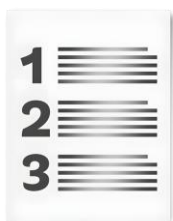
The money comes from the UK Government (Crisis and Resilience Fund).



People who get Housing Benefit or Universal Credit housing costs and need extra help can apply



Before you apply check your details are correct (income, rent, who lives with you).



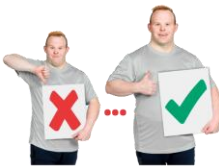
Proof you may need



- Bank statements (2 months)



- Rent proof/arrears



- Proof you tried to improve things



- Health/disability evidence (if you have it)



If you get Universal Credit, also send:



- Proof of Housing costs



- Last 2 months awards



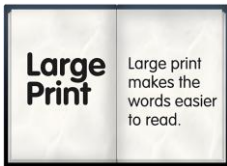
- Tenancy agreement



- Your landlord's contact details

Read aloud, large print and translations are available (use Accessibility Tools).



The fund is limited. We look at your income and what you spend.



If successful, we will send you a letter.



If you do not agree with the decision, email revs@enfield.gov.uk within 1 month to ask for a review.

The review decision is final. There is no right of appeal.
