NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield (the Council) have made the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Personalised Disabled Person) (No. 1) Order 2025 and the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 3) Order 2025 under the section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:
  - (a) Designate a personalised disabled person's parking place in the streets specified in the first paragraph of the heading to this Notice in which a disabled person's vehicle which displays a valid a personalised disabled person's parking place permit issued by the Council, may be left therein;
  - (b) Remove certain personalised disabled persons' parking places in the streets specified in the second paragraph of the heading to this Notice which are no longer required; and
  - (c) Remove certain disabled persons parking places in the streets specified in the third paragraph of the heading to this Notice, which are no longer required.

3. ### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

#### **PROPOSED CHANGES TO PERSONALISED DISABLED PERMIT PARKING PLACES AND DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES IN VARIOUS ROADS THROUGHOUT THE BOROUGH**

The personalised disabled person permit parking places are intended to address the need for a specific parking place for the disabled applicant that meets the Council's criteria which would not be met by the general use disabled bay. This is because a general use disabled bay is available for any motorist whose vehicle is carrying a disabled person and displays the disabled persons 'Blue' badge. The revocation of personalised disabled person permit parking places and disabled person parking places are necessary as those parking places are no longer required.

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The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Personalised Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on 21 July 2025.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order “the Order of 2017” means the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Personalised Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2017(b).

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

(3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2017 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability occurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2017 shall have effect as though:

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(a) 1984 c.27 (b) L.B.E. 2017/23

(1) for the items numbered **(08), (022), (033), (311), (328), (351), (359), (394), (498), (510), (563), (577), (586), (629), (693) and (694)**, in the Schedule to that Order are hereby revoked; and

(2) there was substituted for items numbered, **(114), (414), (702), (703) and (712)** in the Order of 2024 the items similarly numbered in the Schedule to this Order;

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2017 thereto

4. (1) Each area on a street comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 1.83 metres, is designated as a parking place.

(2) The provisions of the Order of 2017 (other than Articles 3, 12 and 13) shall apply to the areas designated as a parking place by this Order, as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to the Schedule to the Order of 2017 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

5. The Council shall place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place designated by this Order and that such parking place may only be used by vehicles specified in Article 4 of the Order of 2017.
