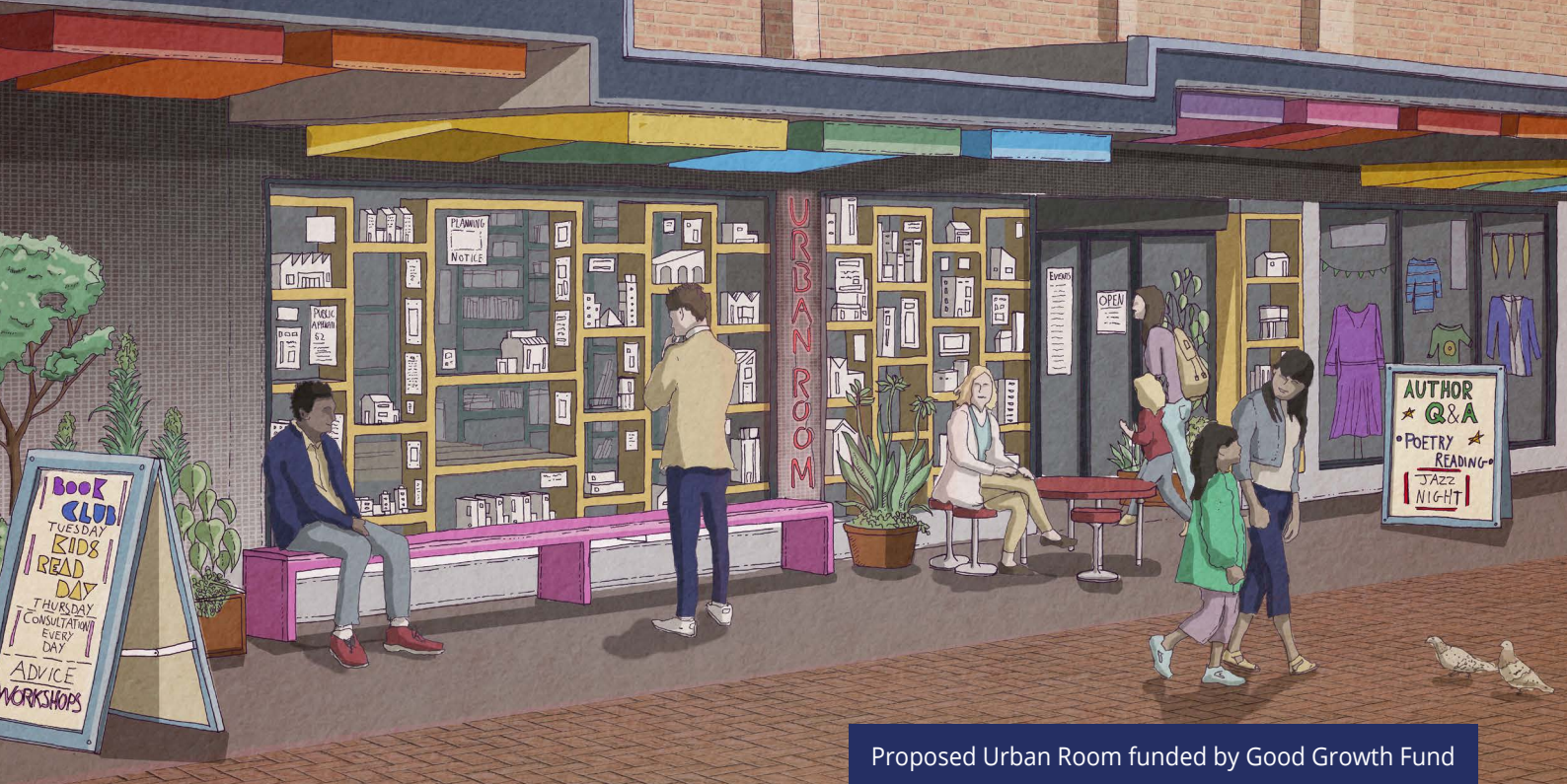

REGENERATION - WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

Enfield Council have taken the decision to postpone the planned face-to-face consultation events and the Joyce & Snells estate ballot until we can guarantee residents can participate safely. Instead of the summer, we now hope to hold the ballot in the Autumn.

However, we will be holding a series of on-line events so residents can continue to comment on the proposals. Information about the first of these events at joyceandsnells.co.uk is on the front of this newsletter and will write to you again with details about future events. These will either be hosted online or held at Boundary Hall depending on how the Government advice on social distancing changes in the coming months.

COUNCIL WINS £1.1M GOOD GROWTH FUNDING

On a positive note, we are delighted that Enfield Council has been awarded £1.1m from the Government's Good Growth Fund to improve local facilities around Angel Edmonton. We will double this, with the funds to be spent on Fore Street providing a new urban room for community engagement, new affordable workspace and new retail space in disused garages.

These improvements mark the beginning of a programme of business support by Enfield Council which will deliver new employment and skills opportunities for all existing residents.
