

TRINITY AVENUE EN1 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential utility works on Trinity Avenue EN1, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield have made the Enfield (Trinity Avenue EN1) (No.1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2026 under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit traffic from entering or proceeding on Trinity Avenue EN1, from outside No.58 for approximately 10 metres either side, as and when directed by signage.
3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services vehicles.
4. The prohibitions will come into operation at any time on 20 August 2026 for 2 days or until works are completed. Access will be maintained for residents as far as the works allow.
5. Whilst the prohibitions are in place the diversion route will be Trinity Avenue, Melbourne Way, First Avenue, St Mark's Road and Trinity Avenue for northbound traffic, and via Melbourne Way, Harrow Avenue, Haileybury Avenue and Trinity Avenue for southbound traffic, and vice versa.
