
As a local living here for 20 years I object to the following parts of the Plan:

Policy SP PL 10, p80-87 & Figure 3.11 (Vicarage Farm) and SA54 p.374 Holly Hill farm: If these very attractive green sites are removed for housing we will lose valuable Carbon/water capture and ruin the environment. Currently we all enjoy walking in these fields and having much needed open space and greenery instead of housing which already dominates the immediate local area. This was intended as greenbelt and I object to losing it when there are other brownfield sites and also other less green areas.

I also object to **Policy DE6 p156-160 and SA2 Palace Gardens & Southgate Circus** because of the tall buildings which will destroy what little remains of the historic character of Enfield town and Southgate and they would block the sky line and views around. The roads are narrow and such large buildings would dominate/darken many pavements and the height is out of character with the whole town nearby.
