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The Enfield Chase has been of significant benefit to borough residents for many centuries. The current draft Local Development Plan seriously diminishes the advantages.

There can be no good reason for spoiling the Green Belt, which has prevented urban sprawl since the 1940s, with policy SP PL10 pages 80-87 and figure 3.11 (Vicarage Farm.) As lifelong residents of the borough, we are also opposed to development at Camlet Way, SA45 page 364 (also part of Enfield Chase) and SA54 page 374, 11 hectares of land at New Cottage and Holly Hill Farms.

In Councillor Caliskan's letter of Summer 2021, recently delivered, she writes of enhancing Enfield's Green Belt. These schemes do not do that and should not go ahead. There should be no Green Belt development in Enfield until all brown field sites have been utilised and even then not on any of the sites mentioned above.
