

We were very surprised to read about the above proposal in the draft local plan. This supermarket is the only large food retailer in the area. In addition it includes a

pharmacy which is open when local chemists have closed, and a clothing section, gardening supplies, travel money and shoe repairs are also available.

There is an Argos outlet which can supply a huge range of items. If the supermarket is closed down people including the elderly and disabled will have to travel to

Enfield Town or further afield for these services. We have been going to this supermarket since the day of opening and it is nearly always very busy. All of these shoppers

will have to go elsewhere should it be redeveloped causing increased volume of traffic and pollution.

The attractive green space at the rear would also be greatly missed by shoppers and local residents who do not have gardens. If it is redeveloped where will the new

residents go for their big shop?

We could not be more strongly against this proposal and hope that the council will reconsider this aspect of the draft plan.
