I would like to voice my objection to the proposed development of Site SA45 of the Land between Camlet Way and Crescent West, Hadley Wood. I have enjoyed visiting friends in the area and wouldn't like to see the loss of the rare green space within London.

Along with the previous, I have outlined my reasons of objection below:

Green Belt Land

I have been made aware of Enfield Council reporting that the area is a “special area of landscape character which is a major asset for the borough. It is of both landscape and historic significance”; and “The existing Green Belt boundary should be retained and protected, and future development and land-use changes resisted”. How can this area then be developed on based on this?

This is opportunistic and not strategic

Keeping in mind my previous point, based on the 2018 consultation document this is clearly not an area of land which was eyed for development but is instead being built on due to opportunism.

Destruction of habitat

Building on green belt land will undoubtedly cause irreparable damage to the ecological habitat.

Not a sustainable development

This area isn't well connected to public transport and the increased pressure of 160 homes will not help.
