We would like to have our objection to the proposed development on the following grounds:-

1. Loss of a local green space and the destruction of a natural habitat for wildlife and removal of precious trees which currently have a preservation order. During Lockdown we came to value this very special space even more so its surprising that at this time there are plans afoot to destroy the quiet space used by all ages especially the elderly. It is a place of calm and tranquility, where people can appreciate nature undisturbed.
2. An increased population emanating from 299 new homes would have a detrimental affect on local infrastructure which is already stretched. Has an impact assessment been done to ascertain the impact on schools. It is doubtful if the current doctors surgeries in the area would be able to cope with more people needing help. As it is getting an appointment with a doctor is virtually impossible.
3. Increased vehicle traffic will have a detrimental affect on the environment. Enfield have been introduced LTN's to reduce carbon monoxide in residential roads. This proposal is at odds with the principle. Clearly this development will only drive up pollution levels in major roads most notable Green Lanes which is already congested.
4. Loss of a major supermarket would have a major impact on the the community forcing us to drive even further for essentials. This of course affects the elderly and those on reduced income.
5. Not in keeping with the character of the area and a blight on the skyline and overdevelopment.
