REF: Proposed Site Allocation No SA45

I am writing to lodge my strong objection to the proposal to build 160 new homes on the Green Belt land between Camlet Way and Crescent West in Hadley Wood.

The reasons for my objection are outlined below;

- 1) The area does not have enough resources to facilitate such a development; The location of the development means that the new residents would need to be able to drive in order to access essential services such as GP, dentist, supermarket , primary and secondary schools. The impact of this on the current residents would be increased pollution, traffic jams and potential road accidents.
- 2) The new development could also result in localized flooding as Hadley wood has a network of underground streams, which would be disturbed by the building of these properties. This has already been demonstrated when other properties have been built in the area and is a major cause of concern for myself because it will put additional pressure on the already weakened sewers and flood defences. Parts of Hadley Wood are in Flood zone 3.
- 3) The proposed development will also ruin this green belt area which gives pleasure to the current local residents. I was under the impression that it was the councils aim to protect Green spaces and bio diversity and as I a local resident I am supportive of these values and concerned about the impact of climate change
