We are London's northernmost borough and once termed London's TOP borough. Consider Enfield in the future and not just 'on your watch'. Plan considerately, once we lose our Green Belt London will just spread out .

PLEASE, PLEASE consider these horrendous plans from people who, I assume, think they are doing the right thing. Think of how people's lives will deteriorate with the increase of traffic.
