I care about the Green Belt. Enfield's Draft Local Plan proposes to remove protection from a large area of the borough's Green Belt so it can be developed as housing and industrial sites. This includes the beautiful farmland - Vicarage Farm - and all of Crews Hill. Green Belt in Hadley Wood is also targeted as well as Holly Hill Farm where the Council proposes to build a logistics hub, while the former Whitewebbs Golf Course will become another football training camp, restricting existing access to local residents.

All these sites lie within the boundaries of the former Enfield Chase and what remains of the Chase has huge historic importance in addition to the many benefits it provides as Green Belt. These sites do not need to be lost. The Council is working against the wishes of the majority of residents, who do not want to build on the Green Belt when there are in fact alternatives that would be better for all Enfield's residents.

Please do not allow this development. Protect our heritage and our right to green areas.
