I would like to register my strong objection to the proposed development of the Sainsbury Site at 681 Green Lanes, N21 3RS.

This will severely impact on the wellbeing of residents already living in this area, with regards to infrastructure (e.g., surgeries, schools, road and traffic congestion), not to mention the already too high pollution levels that exist in the area.

There is the problem of overpopulation of the area, we have had flats being built all along Green Lanes, with further proposals at the Travis Perkins site.

The loss of Sainsbury's will cause great concern to many locals, who rely on this facility.
