I would just like to register my feedback about the local plan for Enfield. It has my full support, and my only criticism would be a lack of greater ambition

There is a desperate need for more homes in the borough. And there's a lot of crappy "green belt" that can be built on. Crews Hill is exactly the right place to start, as it's little more than scrub land, but with great transport connections. Ideally, there should be ambition for 10-12k homes there, but it's a good start. The scheme close to Oakwood is also a good piece of thinking and should be encouraged. The so called green belt in those areas is of little value and should be a key focus for development

I would also like to see an extension of the plans to the area around the Royal Chace hotels, which sits on the edge of excellent development land and remains within walking distance of Gordon Hill station. There should be plans to build here and to extend along the Ridgeway toward the M25.

Ideally, there should be development across as much of the green belt inside the M25 as possible. It's of little value as it is, and would be better used as land for new towns and villages with connections to local infrastructure. I think the council should be much more ambitious, and ignore noise from the local NIMBYs. We need a LOT more housing, and need to show real ambition to deliver it.
